	EAc4: Renewable Energy Supply	Promotes the use of renewable energy during the production of ceramic tiles.

	EAc5: Measurement and Verification of Energy Performance	Evaluates the energy performance of products throughout their useful life, considering the information from the EPD.
Indoor Environment Quality	EQc2: Low VOC Materials	Use products with a low content of volatile organic compounds.
